	Ndoto provides school tuition, boarding, school supplies, meals, and medical expenses for the students accepted into the program.
	Students apply for the program and the accepted students are supplied with all of the previous mentioned expenses. These children
	would not be able to go to school otherwise, and without an education they would not be able to thrive in their communities. The
	students in the program are also able to get medical care when needed. One of the students was found to have cancer and Ndoto wa
	able to pay for his treatment as well as for his schooling. Ndoto also disciples the children through visitation to their schools and
	retreats held during the year. In addition to having their expense paid, the students are also expected to contribute by doing service work and mentoring some of the younger students. For 2013 we served approximately 175 students.

	The Kenyan staff is invaluable to our efforts. Not only do they pay school fees, buy supplies and take the students to the doctor
	when they are sick, but they invest in and mentor these young people. This is an important part of our work, because all of our
	Kenyan staff have come from poor and struggling backgrounds themselves. They are able to take their experiences (often which have been very tough) and use them for good to teach the students. This is a key to our development as we use local people for our
	work instead of large teams of people from abroad. This aids in the community impact we seek to make and it creates jobs in an
	economy that often times experiences 60%+ unemployment.
