OPEN DOORS

Ndoto sponsors the education and discipleship of hundreds of students in schools all over the country. We select students as young as first grade and we are able to sponsor them through college if their grades allow. By removing financial barriers, the next generation is free to dream again.

Zadock dreamed with us. After his dad passed away, his mom struggled to raise the school fees for him and his two siblings. His grades and discipline were exemplary, however, and Ndoto gave him a chance that would have been impossible otherwise: attending Moi University to study chemical engineering.

“As a born-again Christian, and a product of Ndoto,” he wrote to us, “I will give back to my community by being the best in my field.” He got a job with the city water and sanitation company and was rapidly promoted to a leadership position due to his integrity and skill.

Zadock invests in Ndoto as well. He is a regular sight around campus, mentoring younger students and speaking at discipleship events. A monthly donation to sponsor a young person may seem like a small thing. But for the recipient, it's transformative. And then the investment multiplies when they themselves begin to give back.



Our team has dreamed of having our own private Christian school for almost as long as we've been working in Kenya. Last year, we realized that dream. Featuring small class sizes, creative educational design, and chapel services, Ndoto Academy is charting a new path in education and offering another way to directly support the education of the next generation.

This year, we have three grades: pre-K, Kindergarten, and 1st grade. We'll add a new grade each year, and the doors are wide open for future growth. Ndoto received grants for one of the nicest playgrounds in town, a computer lab with 25 Chromebooks, and two vans for the school and ministry. Then, in early 2023, we purchased a large plot of adjoining land that gives us what we need to build all the way to 9th grade.

In addition to another option for sponsored students, Ndoto Academy is a key way that we build capacity in our community. Education is the key to development, and we're not just offering any education – it's the highest-quality education we can imagine and you're helping us build it.





Ndoto's impact goes far beyond the programs that students apply for. We reach out to the entire community with Ndoto Community Church, which is a spiritual home for hundreds.

Since young people are drawn to sports, we've been building the Ndoto Sports Academy. In addition to several teams for different ages and genders practicing their skills, Ndoto FC plays competitive young adult soccer in a county league. Others come to our

gym for aerobics, weightlifting, and boxing. Boxers from our gym have competed across the country and won awards.

In a difficult job environment, basic skills and vocational training are more important than ever. Last year we began offering a certificate course in computers on our campus. Between all of our programs, we have open doors to transform our city. With the generous support of so many, we are only limited by the size of our dreams. We hope you'll partner with us to walk through these open doors!

Our mission is to educate, disciple, and develop at risk families to make their dreams a reality, glorify God, and use their gifts to transform their community.
